CURRICULUM COURSE #1

HORTICULTURE: Students will learn introductory horticulture, which includes plant life cycles and applicable environmental factors. Information is also presented on nomenclature and classification of plants, exhibiting procedures, judging procedures, point scoring and top NGC Awards.

Plants to be studied: Annuals (Coleus) and Herbaceous Perennials (Salvia)

<u>DESIGN</u>: An introduction to floral design, including a brief history of designs, the Principles and Elements of Design, Design Types, selecting components for designs, point scoring, judging procedures and top NGC Awards.

Designs: Traditional Line, Line-Mass, and Mass

FLOWER SHOW PROCEDURE: An introduction to the *The Handbook for Flower Shows,* the six basic requirements of Standard Flower Shows, categories and types of Flower Shows, the standard system of awarding and the philosophy of point scoring. EXAMS - If Course is taken for Credit

Point Scoring Exams in Horticulture and Design will be graded, but the scores are not recorded.

Written Exams Required in Horticulture, Design, Flower Show Procedure – 3 hours.
