Pam Braun- Flower Show Procedure and Horticulture. A garden club member for over 40 years. Pam is currently a member of Leipers Fork Garden Club, which she founded in 2004. She is a board member for TN Federation of Garden Clubs, TN District II, Deep South Garden Clubs, Inc and NGC. She is an NGC accredited master flower show judge and NGC horticulture, flower show procedure, and symposium instructor, member of fourteen different plant societies and judge for four of them.

She specializes in exhibiting collections and displays of numerous different plant groups and has won numerous top exhibitor awards for her horticulture. Besides horticulture, she enjoys floral design and has been a speaker, leader of workshops, or exhibitor at all levels from district to internationally. She enjoys growing plants all her life and the plant material she uses for both design and instruction often comes from her own garden or indoor plants

Kathleen Hawryluk – Design

Kathleen is an award winning floral designer, moved to Naples, Florida twelve years ago from Huntington, Long Island, New York where she was President of the Nathan Hale Garden Club. Now a member of Naples Garden Club and Gulf Coast Garden Club, she served for three years as Chair of the Naples Flower Show which is held in March each year. Two of these shows won awards at the State level and also National level. She is an accredited NGC Flower Show Master Judge, former Director of Judges Council District IX, former President of Naples Ikebana International #160, current Director of District IX, Secretary of CFAA, Vice President of Florida State Judges Council, certified Judges Flower Show School Design Instructor and a certified Sogetsu Instructor (Ikebana). She recently chaired the 2018 Florida State Flower Show “Fabulous Florida”.

Kathleen gives floral demonstrations all over the country and in Nassau, Bahamas. She was a speaker at CFAA (Creative Floral Arrangers of the Americas) in February 2015, and in San Francisco at OFAD (Organization of Floral Arts Designers) in August 2016. Named “Designer of Distinction” for 2016 by the Jacksonville Garden Club, she gave a program for them in January, 2016. Ohio Judges Council welcomed her to present a program in May 2017, and in October 2018 will be in Atlanta again presenting to the Georgia NGC Judges.
